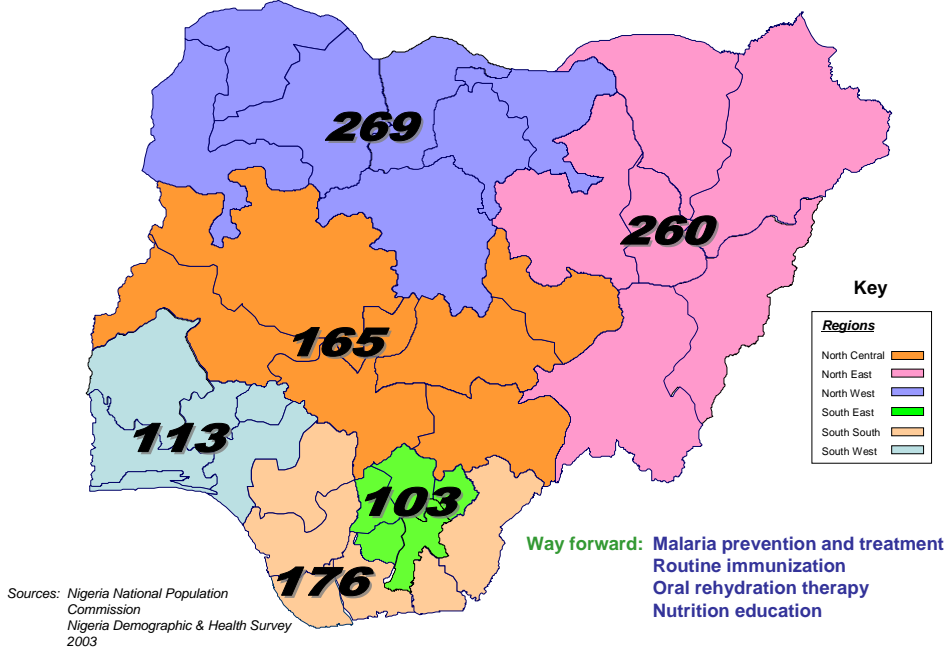


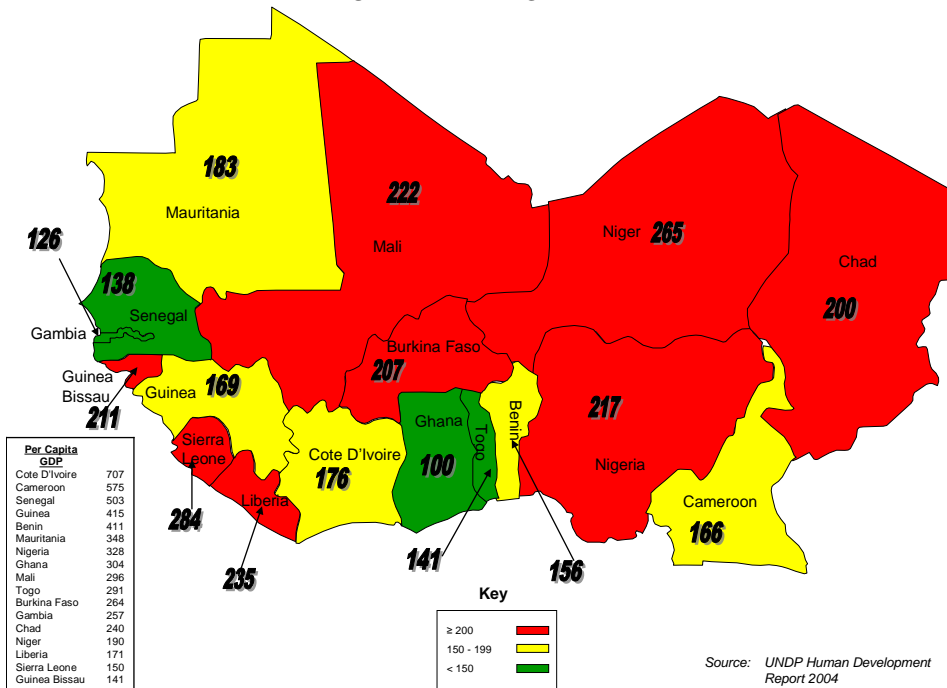

National average, 217/1000 live births (Nigeria 1990: 192.4)

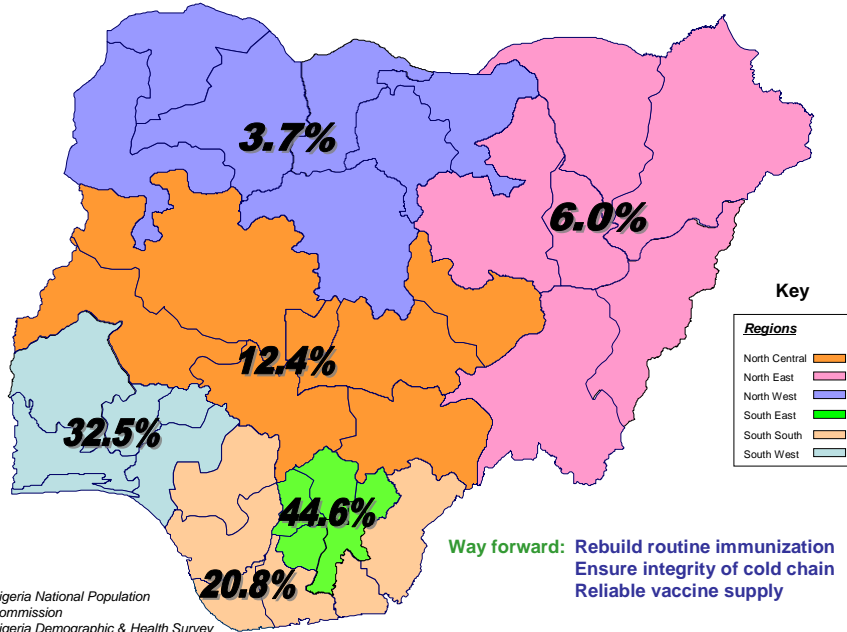


UNDER-FIVE MORTALITY



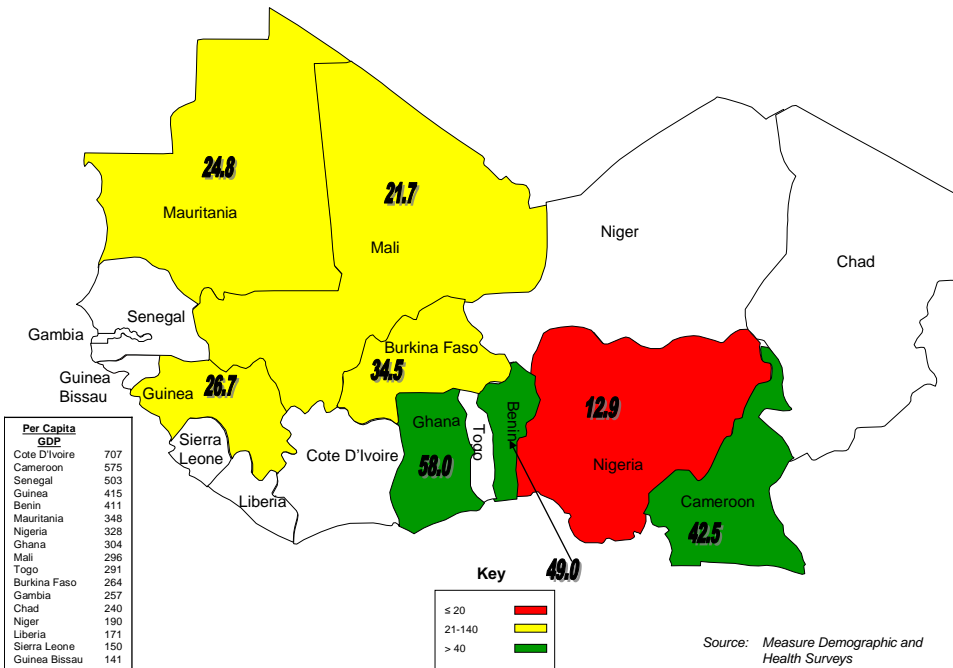
COMPLETE IMMUNIZATION

National average, 12.9% (Nigeria 1990: 18.3%)



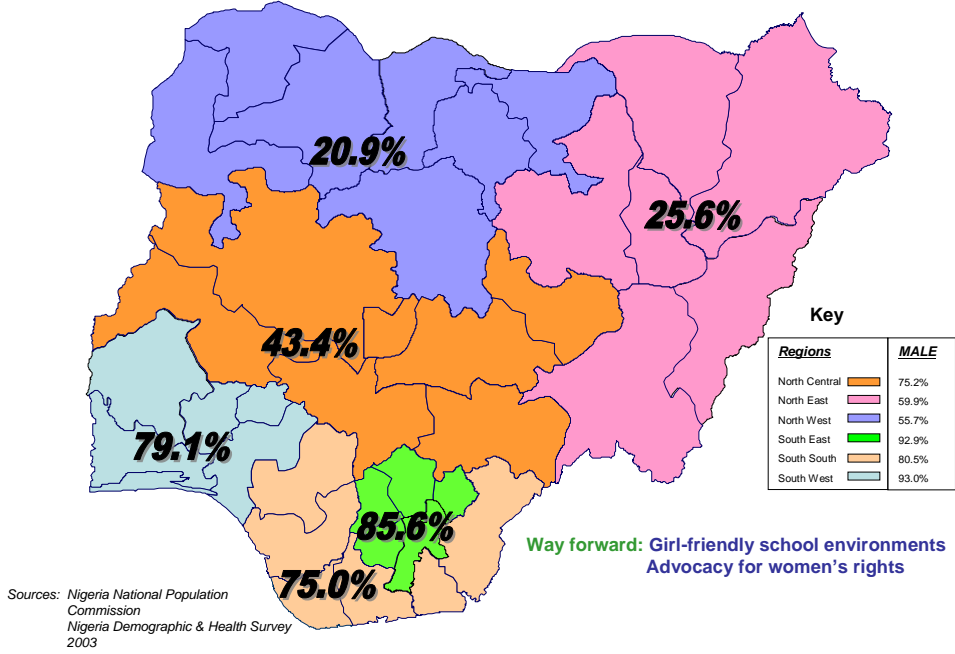

COMPLETE IMMUNIZATION

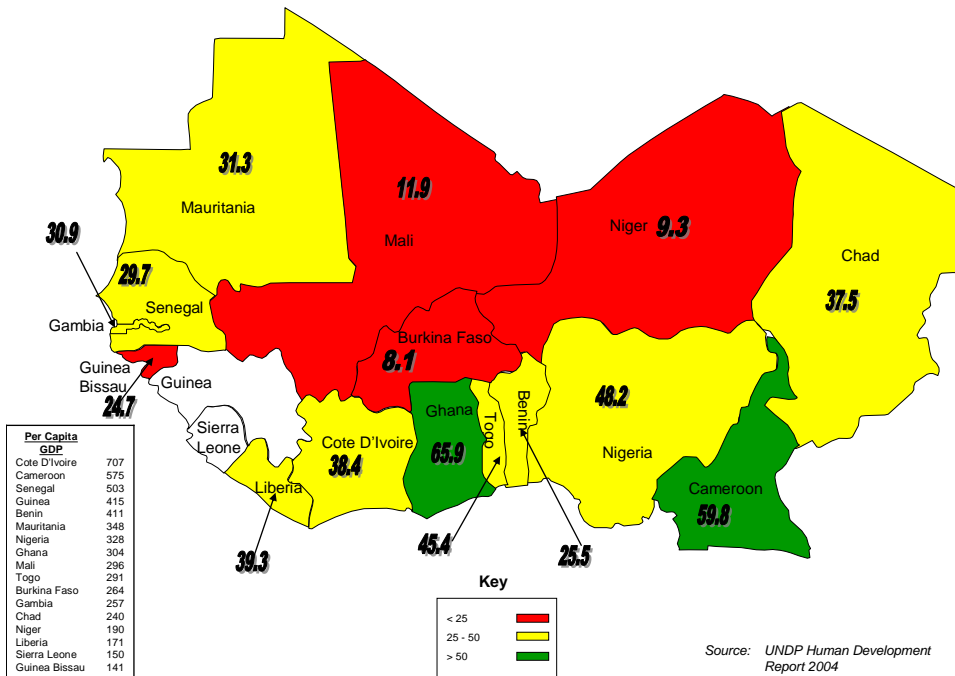


WOMEN'S LITERACY

National average, 48.2% (Nigeria 1990: 40%)

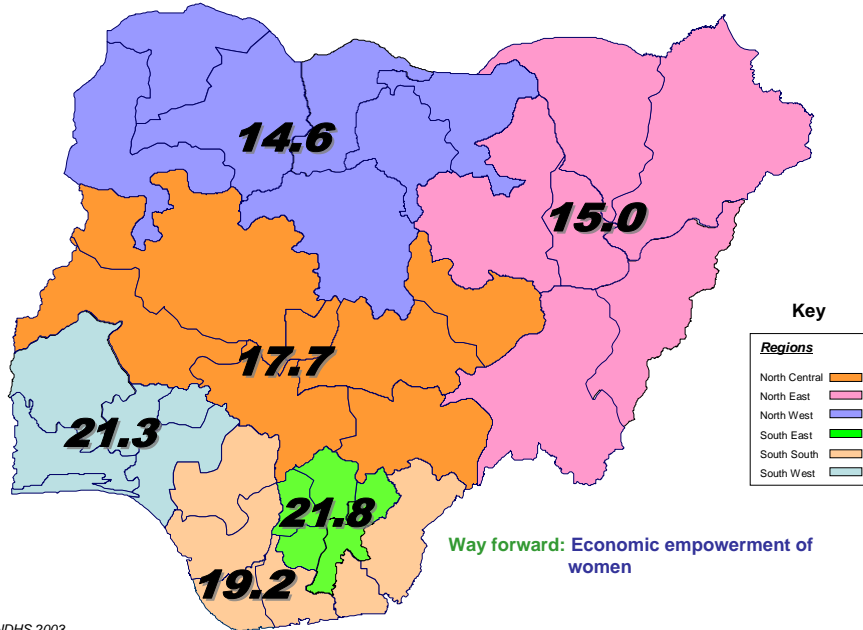


WOMEN'S LITERACY



MEDIAN AGE AT FIRST MARRIAGE: WOMEN

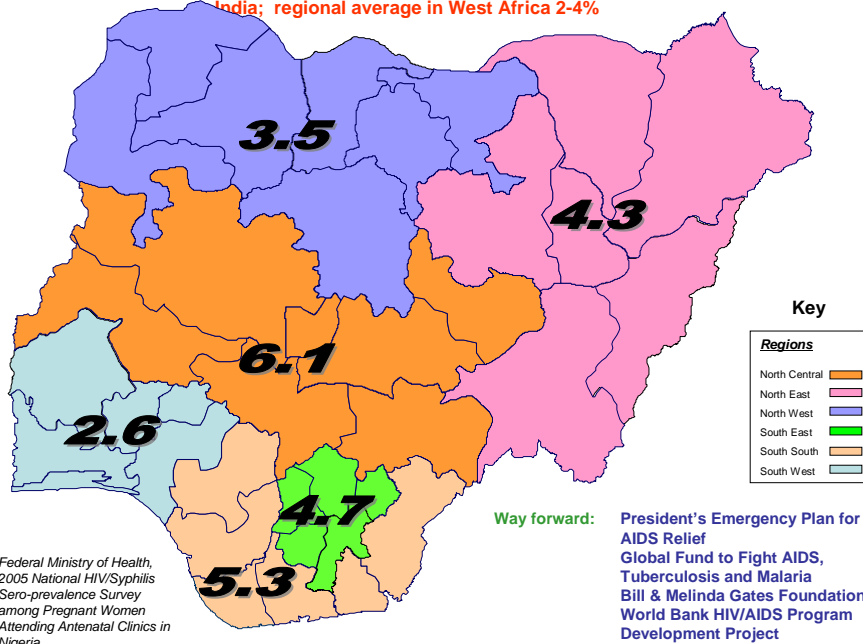

National average, 4.4 Number of PLWHA 3 million, the third-highest in the world after South Africa and India; regional average in West Africa 2-4%

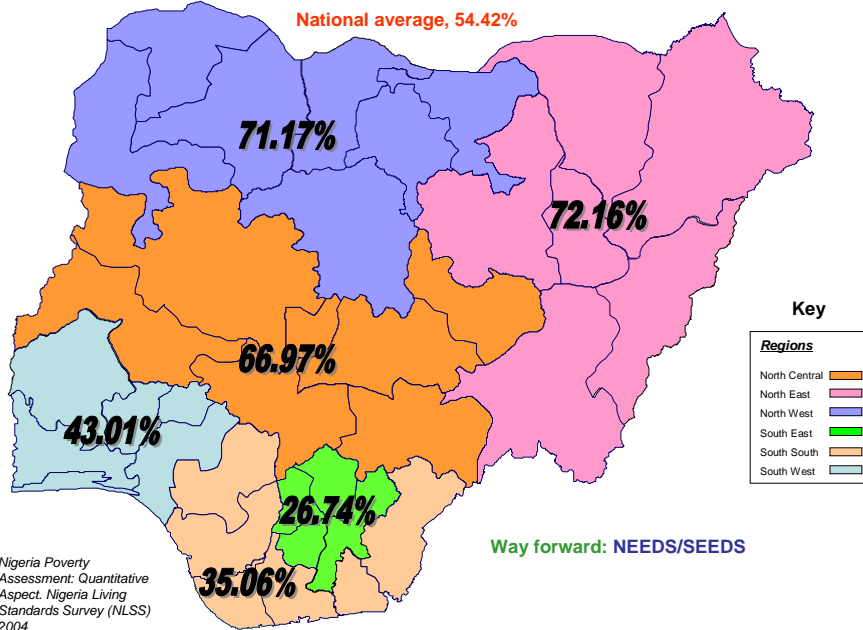

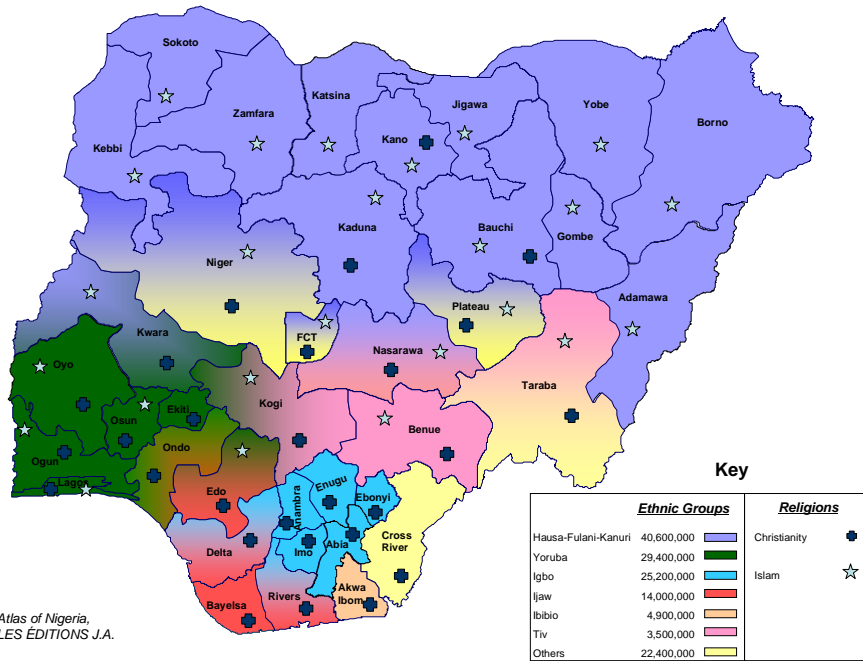
