## Planning process - Journey so far

- UNFPA Nigeria 6<sup>th</sup> Country plan of Action developed with NPC – mid 2008
- Plan to support 12+1 state from 2009 – 2012
- State work plans developed – Dec 2008
- Approved four year and 2009 work plans released - May 2009
- LOU signed – June 2009 (Except Borno)
- Programme and financial management training – July 2009 (3<sup>rd</sup> quarter justification & face)



# UNFPA 6<sup>th</sup> CP Priorities - 1

## *Reproductive health and rights component*

- **Output 1:** Improved gender responsive and equitable **HIV preventive services for women** and youth in 12 states and at the Federal level.
- **Output 2:** Strengthened institutional capacity to ensure reproductive health commodity security and deliver gender sensitive and equitable **family planning services** at Federal level and in 12 supported States' institutions and NGOs
- **Output 3:** Increased gender sensitive and culturally appropriate quality **maternal health services**, including **Emergency obstetrical** and **neonatal care** in 360 facilities in 12 supported States.
- **Output 4:** Enhanced knowledge, skills and mechanism to **demand** for, and **access** quality gender sensitive and equitable Reproductive health/Family Planning and HIV/AIDS prevention services in selected communities in 12 supported States.

# UNFPA 6<sup>th</sup> CP Priorities - 2

## *Population and development component*

- **Output 1:** Strengthened technical and institutional capacities of 3 Federal and 12 supported states institutions to collect, analyze, manage, disseminate and use gender sensitive data
- **Output 2:** Strengthened capacity of Federal and 12 States institutions to incorporate population issues into policies, development strategies and expenditure frameworks
- **Output 3:** Enhanced capacity of Federal, 12 States institutions and Civil Society Organisations to advocate for, develop, implement and monitor **Youth Friendly policies**, plans, programmes and expenditure frameworks.

# UNFPA 6<sup>th</sup> CP Priorities - 3

## *Gender equality*

- **Output 1:** Strengthened technical and operational capacity of Federal and 12 supported State Ministries and civil society organizations to **promote women's rights and political empowerment**
- **Output 2:** Enhanced capacity of Federal, 12 States institutions and policy makers, parliamentarians and civil society organizations to advocate for, develop, implement, and monitor policies and programmes that **reduce Gender Based Violence.**



# UNFPA support modalities

- Solely a donor agency (Not implementing)
- Through Government and NGOs:
  - Federal and State MDAs
  - RHR** by MOH & MOE
  - P&D** by Planning commission & MOYD
  - Gender equity** by MOWA & MOI
- Operate within annual approved work plan
- **Funding options** -**Direct cash transfers** - **commonest**
  - Direct payments** - to vendors
  - Reimbursements** – to vendors

# IMNCH related outputs / activities in



## Adamawa state - 1

- **RHR OUT PUT1 :Improved Gender Responsive and Equitable HIV/AIDS preventive services for women and youths**
- Implement **an assessment** of the availability and quality of Maternal health; RH/FP and HIV services at the state and LGA levels (public and non-governmental sector).
- Reprint and distribute 5000 copies of RH/HIV integration guidelines to States and LGAs.
- Collaborate with NGOs to **establish at least one HCT service site in each LGA**
- Conduct **training of HCT for 100 health workers** on HCT counseling and testing
- **Provide HCT equipment and consumables** for health facilities to provide sustainable services
- Support in collaboration with NGO facilities in each LGAs and State level (through technical assistance and resource materials) to provide **HIV prevention information as part of ANC services**
- Conduct 5 – day **media material development** for RH/HIV/AIDS/Maternal Health/FP
- Produce and disseminate 10, 000 copies of IEC materials to various stakeholder groups.

# IMNCH related outputs / activities in Adamawa state - 2

- **RHR OUTPUT 2 :Strengthened Institutional capacity to ensure Reproductive Health commodity security and deliver gender sensitive and equitable family planning services**
- . Conduct a rapid **assessment of the CLMS** in Adamawa state.
- . Conduct **training for 125 Health workers in CLMS** (Contraceptive Logistic Management System)
- One day **advocacy meeting** for 100 persons consisting of LGA Chairmen and LGA Councilors Health; LGA Director PHC; LGA RH Coordinators
- Organize **quarterly technical meeting** of State and LGA RH programme managers to review status of RH services (RHCS/RH/FP/HIV) at state and LGA level
- Conduct capacity and baseline **assessment of NGOs, CSOs engaged in CBD activities.**

# IMNCH related outputs / activities in Adamawa state - 3

- **RHR Output 3 : Increased gender sensitive and culturally appropriate quality Maternal Health services including emergency obstetric and Neonatal care in 30 Health Facilities**
- Organize **training on ELSS** for 16 doctors
- Organize **training for** 60 Midwives/Nurses on **LSS**
- Participate in 5 – day **training for** 30 officials drawn from the 21 LGAs and 6 line Ministries Officials on **Monitoring and Evaluation**.
- Organize a day meeting on modalities for the formation of Core-Technical Committee (CTC) comprising of ; Director PHC, Director Hospital Service, Director Nursing, Director Food, Drugs , O&G specialist, CAN, FOMWAN, M&HWs, NCWS.
- Provide regular budget for CTC for quarterly meetings.
- Undertake 10 day quarterly M&E to state and LGA facilities
- Participate in the 5 – day **Training for** 30 state programme managers and CBOs/FBOs/YSOs officers **Results Based Management (RBM)**.
- Conduct a rapid **assessment of fistula treatment capacity** in the state
- Support the **training** of Health teams in **Obstetric fistula care**
- Facilitate fistula treatment services through the **provision of consumables and basic equipment**

# IMNCH related outputs / activities in Adamawa state - 4

- **RHR Output 4: Enhanced knowledge, skills and mechanism to demand for, and access quality gender sensitive and equitable reproductive health/family planning and HIV/AIDS prevention services in selected communities in Adamawa State.**
- Procurement of computers - 3 computers, 1 printer and One UPS

# IMNCH related outputs / activities in Adamawa state - 5

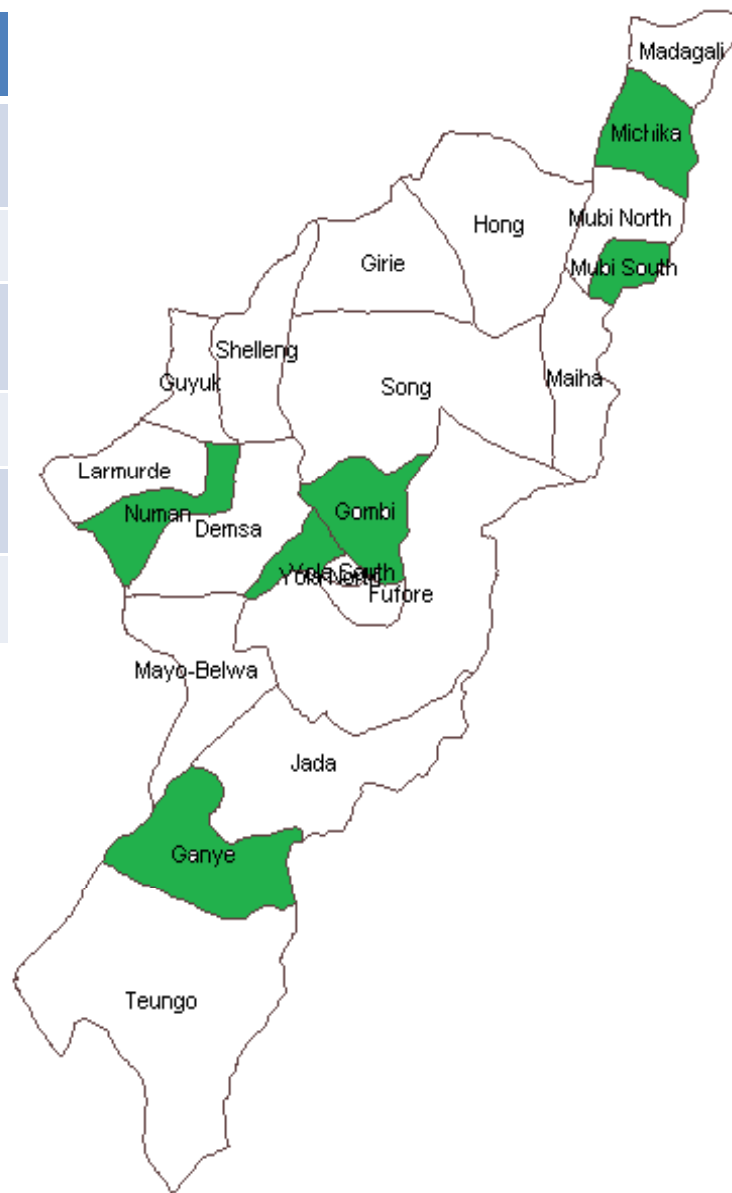
- **GE Output:1 Strengthened technical and operational capacity** of Adamawa State Ministry of Women Affairs and Civil Society Organizations **to promote women's right and political empowerment.**
- **Advocacy** visits to policy makers at all levels & HCOWA
- Participate in 5 – day training for 30 state programme managers and CBOs/FBOs/YSOs officers Results Based Management (RBM).
- Organize **quarterly meeting** for 200 participants drawn from female legislators, commissioners, LGA/Dev. Areas chairpersons, Female councillors and Leaders of Women Community groups for information sharing on women

# IMNCH related outputs / activities in Adamawa state - 6

- **GE Output 2 : Enhanced capacity** of Adamawa State Institutions and Policy Makers, Legislators and Civil Society Organizations **to advocate for, develop, implement and monitor policies and programmes that reduce Gender Based Violence (GBV)**
- Establish and hold Biannual **meetings of the Inter-faith forum on GBV**
- Organize one-day **sensitization workshop** in collaboration with NGO **on GBV for 200 uniform personnel** drawn from amongst the agencies in the state
- Organize in collaboration with FIDA/NBA/CSOs a one-day **sensitization on GBV for Two (2) police officers** from each division
- **Support** the activities of the Network of **Traditional Communicators**
- Establish and facilitate quarterly meetings of the State Gender Working Group (SGWG)
- Facilitate the development of a **rehabilitation strategy** and guide **for obstetric fistula**.
- Conduct **training** 35 Social workers and women development officers **in fistula counseling and rehabilitation**.
